- Note: As of year-end, there are 6 employees on payroll.

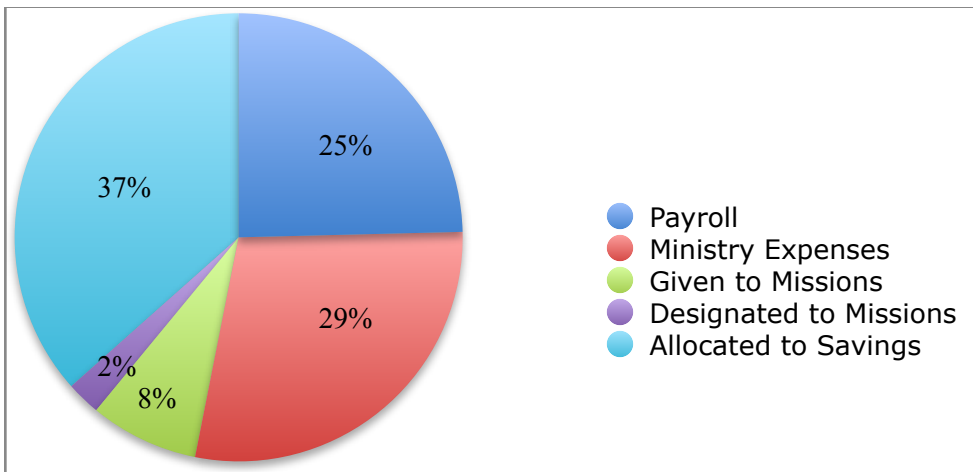
Savings: 156,011.70

Projected Income Received: 540,000.00

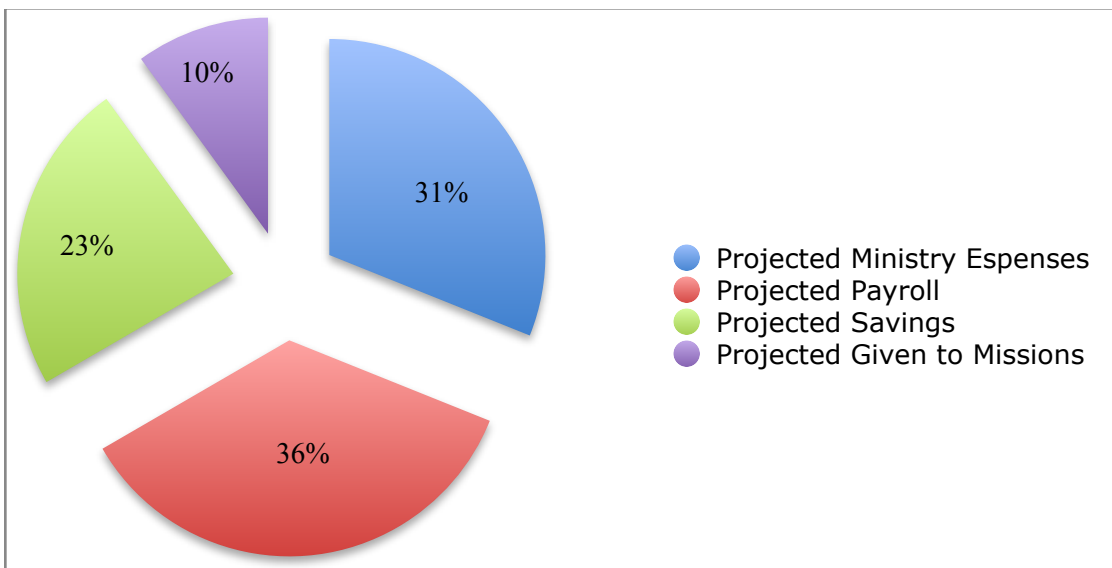
Projected Ministry Expenses: 167,815.00
