Family Devotionals for the week of March 29th

“The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace.”

-Numbers 6:24-26

Supplies you will need:

- One 8.5X11” piece of paper, folded in half
- Something to color with: Crayons, markers, coloring pencils, paints
- Scissors (optional)
- Glue stick (optional)

1) Take time, as a family, to pray and ask the Holy Spirit to show you someone God wants to share His heart with while everyone is staying home. Maybe it is a neighbor, a family member you don't live with, or a friend.

2) Pray today's verse for this person. For example, *“God, would You bless them and keep them and shine Your face on them. Turn Your face towards them and give them peace.”*

3) Ask the Holy Spirit to show you how to decorate your folded piece of paper into a card for this person. Use your imagination and Crayons, markers, coloring pencils or paints, to partner with the Holy Spirit and decorate the outside of the folded paper, keeping the person you are praying for and the verse in your mind.

4) You can print out and decorate one of the oval templates with part of your message. Cut out the oval and glue it to the front of the card.

5) As a family, write a message together on the inside the card and deliver it to the person you are praying for. You could tape it to their front door, put it in the mail, or deliver it with canned foods or other items to leave on their front porch. It's up to you and your family!

You and your family are a blessing that God is partnering with to share His peace with others!
