Family Devotional May 10th, 2020

Jesus said " You are the light of the world...let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." Matt 5: 14-16

Let's sing of how you will let your light shine for Jesus!

I'm gonna shine my light for you....

This weeks activity is to help you remember that you are the light of the world and you are to let your light shine! Last week we talked of how Jesus is the light of the world, but since He lives in you that makes you the light of the world. What's does it mean to shine His light? It means that God wants us to tell others about Him, & share His love. In today's bible verse Jesus tells us to let our light shine. The good news of Jesus is so amazing we want to share it with other people. We want to let *His* light shine for all to see. We want to light up the whole world with God's love! But how do you get His light in you? That's a good question. Let's think about out a lamp, find a lamp in your house. Now turn it on, did it light up? What happens if you unplug it? It won't work if it's not plugged into the power source. Just like a lamp needs to be plugged in to power in order to shine, we need to be plugged into Jesus, our source of power in order to shine. Discuss with your family ways we plug into Jesus to receive our power and ways we let our light shine. Now that your plugged in....Shine Your Light! .

Additional questions to discuss throughout the week:

When was a time you knew your power from Jesus needed to be recharged?
How did you feel during this time? What did you do to recharge?
Share a story about a time you let your light shine.
How did it make you and others feel?



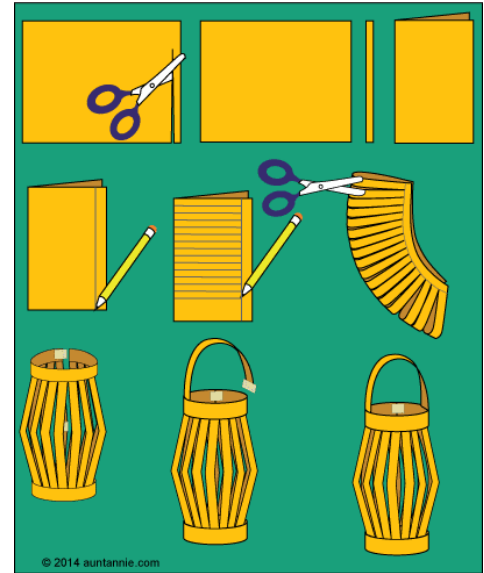

LET YOUR LIGHT SHINE ACTIVITY



1. Take a rectangular sheet of paper. Cut a strip of paper from the long edge of the paper(about 1" width)
2. Set it aside. It's for the handle.
3. Fold the paper.
4. Mark a line across the length of the folded paper $\frac{1}{2}$ " in from the open edge.
5. Make marks every $\frac{1}{2}$ " or 1" along this line, then draw lines at each mark straight to the folded edge. Write ways to shine on these strips.
6. Cut on these lines from the folded edge to the original marked line, cut through both layers of paper.
7. Open the paper flat, then loop the paper around to form a tube, tape or staple it closed.
8. Attach the Handle you made in step 1 and you're done!
